



GB CAUTION

- Never remove the plug from the power supply by pulling on the lead.
- The illuminated globe is not a toy. Children should use it only under adult supervision.
- The illuminated globe is an electric appliance if placed on raised surfaces, make sure it is stable to avoid slipping or falling.
- A damaged cable should only be replaced by the manufacturer or qualified persons without exception.
- If after unpacking and connecting, the lamp does not light, please examine in the indicated manner to see if the bulb is firm in its base.
- Keep these instructions for future reference.

Directions for changing the bulb
(first of all disconnect from the mains)

- Disconnect electric supply before changing bulb. Carefully pull up the meridian arc, until the axle comes out of the globe. (Picture 1).
- Hold the meridian arc up and push the globe forward (Picture 2 - arrow direction 2).
- Be careful not to scratch the globe with the axle. Now lift out the globe from the lamp base (Picture 2 - arrow direction 3) and screw the light bulb (picture 3 - arrow direction 4).

ATTENTION!

Please take care to fit the correct replacement bulbs:

- 20, 25, 30 cm. diameter globes
 - do not exceed 25 Watt bulb type E14
- 40 cm. diameter globe
 - do not exceed 40 Watt bulb type E14

DISPOSAL OF PLUG - Applicable for UK and IRL only

If the non rewirable plug is to be cut off, the removed plug should be disposed of carefully as there is a shock hazard should the plug be inserted into a live socket.

REPLACING FUSE - Applicable for UK and IRL only

The detachable fuse cover must be replaced after changing the fuse. Only a 3 amp fuse should be used and should comply with BS1363 fitted with 3 amp fuse.

The wires in the mains lead are coloured in accordance with the following code:

- Blue ----- Neutral
- Brown ----- Live

The wires in the mains lead must be connected to the terminals in the plug as follows:

| Wire colour | Plug terminal marking |
| Blue ----- | N or Black or Blue |
| Brown ----- | L or Red or Brown |

Do not connect either wire to the earth terminal. If the mains plug contains a fuse this should be 3 amp, if a plug without a fuse is used the distribution board fuse should not be greater than 5 amp.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ASSEMBLING THE GLOBE

Illuminated globes come either assembled or unassembled. If the globe in this box is composed of two separate parts (sphere and base) please follow the instructions below:

- A) - Insert the lower part of the arc (either a bayonet or screw fitting) into the base.
- B) - Turn the base until you achieve a perfect fit.
